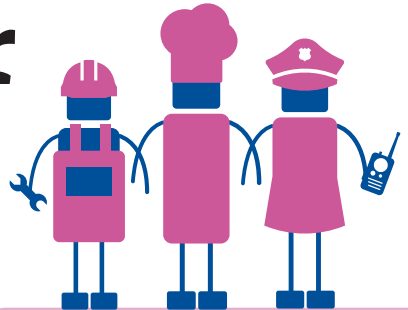


# Looking after someone?

## Who is a carer?

A carer is anyone who cares, unpaid, for a friend or family member who needs help due to illness, disability, a mental health condition or an addiction.

If you give significant support to another person, irrespective of whether you live with that person or not, you are considered a carer, even if the person you care for is unable, or even unwilling to acknowledge your involvement.
